ON GOING PROJECTS –

A. TALKING BOOK LIBRARY: Library membership for the visually impaired has reached 1250 members. The details below are for the financial year 2008-2009.

Books in Cassette Format:

1. Total No of Books recorded: 99
2. Master Cassettes: 533
3. Copy of Cassettes: 5161 (3900 cassettes were recorded on individual request and 1261 cassettes were requested by institutions)
4. New library members: 82

Books in DAISY (CD) format:

2. Master Daisy CDs: 267 (Including DAISY books, e text Books, Cassette to CD converted Books)

Improvement in DAISY DTB Technology in the Library:

1. Another Technology called Dolphin Producer and Save As Daisy was introduced to the Library and few books are produced using these technologies, it converts full text to full audio format.
2. We are planning to introduce new software called Obi, it has advanced features than Sigtuna which we currently use to produce the Talking Books.
Obi's advanced features will help the visually challenged person to better navigate and easily read the book as he or she wants.

Other:

-Recording studios was set up at Intel. Volunteers from Intel are recording books for Mitra Jyothi at their convenience at their office.

B. COMPUTER TRAINING CENTRE: Mitra Jyothi provides free computer training courses for the Visually Impaired. Following were the courses conducted for the previous year

- Short Term Basic Computer Course (2 months): April to June 2008
Students: 12
- TTC (Teachers Training Course): May 2008
Candidates: 16
- Internet Workshop: June 2008
Candidates: 12
- CCCT Basic (9 months): August 2008 to April 2009
Students: 15

C. JOB PLACEMENT CELL: We did not have a full time staff member working in the Placement Cell last year. We placed 20 candidates for the year.

D. BRAILLE TRANSCRIPTION CENTRE: The Braille Transcription Centre caters to anyone who wants books converted to Braille. We convert textbooks, storybooks, magazines etc. We have converted about 45 books to Braille and 250 copies have been made.

E. INDEPENDENT LIVING SKILLS: This course has been customized to suit individual requirements of the trainees according to their needs. 14 girls have benefitted from this course.

(Please note: EnAble India utilizes Mitra Jyothi's premises to conduct their Medical Transcription Course. The students of the course make use of Mitra Jyothi's hostel facility)
